INFORMATION STATEMENT IN TERMS OF SECTION 33 (1) (a) (i) (aa) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT: MUNICIPAL FINANCE MANAGEMENT ACT, NO 56 OF 2003 THAT LAINGSBURG MUNICIPALITY ("THE MUNICIPALITY") INTENDS ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF HIGH SECURITY LOCKS AND KEYS FOR A PERIOD OF 10 YEARS

TENDER DESCRIPTION: SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF HIGH SECURITY

LOCKS AND KEYS FOR A PERIOD OF 10 YEARS

In terms of section 33 of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, No. 56 of 2003, Laingsburg Municipality ("the Municipality") intends to enter into a contract for the supply and delivery of high security locks and keys for a period of 10 years. The contract will impose financial obligations on the Municipality for a period longer than the three years covered in the annual budget for 2022/2023 financial year.

#### 1. PURPOSE

The Municipality intends on entering into a contract with a supplier for the supply and delivery of high security locks and keys. This will enable the Municipality to have a suitable supplier for the supply and delivery of high security locks, keys, hasps, carry kits and associated equipment for the purposes of locking various high risk equipment. The locks shall be specifically registered in the name of the Municipality and shall contain various security locking levels which shall be able to be operated by a Keyed Alike Master Key System.

### 2. TERM OF THE CONTRACT

The contract will be for a period of ten (10) years.

### 3. OBLIGATIONS

The supplier shall be responsible for the supply and delivery of high security locks and keys for use within the Electricity, Water, Effluent Treatment, Solid Waste and similar environments as well as supporting equipment.

In terms of the proposed agreement, the Municipality will place an order with the supplier as per the specifications on a, as and when needed basis depending on the available budget and the required needs.

The financial implications for the Municipality will be as follows:

All prices shall be firm for an initial period up to **30 June 2023**. Upon reaching the end of the period mentioned above, the service provider must formally apply for a price increase and which increases shall be based on mainly the price increase indices applicable to the Aluminium content of the padlocks and the increases shall be calculated from a base date of **01 January 2023**. Price increases need to be applied for, and to be firm for the whole of each financial year of the Municipality from **01 July 2023** onwards.

Price increases will be based on formula, based on SEIFSA indices and if no formula is supplied, the price increase will be calculated as follows:

 New Price = Old Price x (SEIFSA Aluminium Manufacturing Index at time of application) / (SEIFSA Aluminium Manufacturing Index of 01 January 2023).

The long term agreement enables the service provider to recoup the expenditure incurred in the research and development that goes into manufacturing the unique locks and keys and is more cost effective for the Municipality.

Provision for the expenditure has been made in the Operational Budgets and will be made in future budgets for the duration of the agreement. It will have no impact on municipal tariffs and revenue.
