### 1. Background

1.1. The Municipality invites suitably experienced and qualified service providers to bid for the supply and delivery of an 80mm diameter Petrol Gasoline Trash Water Pump complete with 10m long suction pipe as per specifications.

### 2. Current State

2.1. The Municipality needs to procure a trash water pump to assist with the cleaning of the Soutkloof Fountain.

### 3. Scope of Work

- 3.1. These are specifications for the supply and delivery of an 80mm diameter Petrol Gasoline Trash Water Pump complete with 10m long suction pipe as per specifications.
- 3.2. The Trash Water Pump is required to assist with the cleaning of the Soutkloof Fountain. Currently there are blockages, which inhibits the free flow of the water from the fountain to the Main Reservoir. This results in the reservoirs running dry and leads to interruption of water supply.
