**Key Duties:** Assist the Electrician in construction, installing and commissioning of electrical networks of the municipality. The following electrical equipment but not limited to:

- Up to 22kV overhead lines and underground cables, switchgear, mini-substations, ring main units, transformers, 400v/230v distribution kiosk, and allied work.
- Up to 22kV cable joining using both compound and heat shrink joints.
- Maintaining street lightings and high mask light.
- Installation of new domestic connections and prepaid meter installations and conversions.
- Undertake the increase/decrease of tariff circuit breakers.
- Undertaking inspections of electrical installation and report on findings in respect of guidelines provided.
- Responsible for on-site OHS and supervision of labour.
